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**Dear Parents/Guardians:**

The staff and members of the American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State Committee are looking forward to having your daughter participate in this 75<sup>th</sup> session of American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State. You can be proud of her for being selected by her school and the local American Legion Auxiliary to attend ALA Badger Girls State. Thank you for permitting her to do this!

**\*(NEW):** Each Delegate will be required to pay a \$25.00 Delegate fee upon arrival at UW-Oshkosh. If paying by check, make it payable to ALABGS. Department will implement a \$25.00 administrative fee for checks returned by the bank.

I highly recommend that you also accompany your daughter to an American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State Orientation scheduled in your area. A list of scheduled orientations in the state and American Legion Auxiliary Badger Girls State Session Information can be viewed on the [www.badgergirlsstate.org](http://www.badgergirlsstate.org) website under the 2018 Orientation tab. You are welcome to attend any one of the Orientations scheduled throughout the state.

If there is a questionable health condition such as recent exposure to communicable disease, disability, temporary handicap or special diet, these must be discussed with the Executive Director Delores Woolf prior to registration.

**Medical Form:**

The medical form is on our website, under the Session Info tab. Completed medical forms should be submitted as soon as possible as an email attachment and sent to [alabgs.reg@gmail.com](mailto:alabgs.reg@gmail.com). It would be advisable to retain a copy of the health form. Our nursing staff will review the form and contact you directly should additional information be needed.

If your daughter is taking a prescription drug, place any prescription drugs or medications in a zip lock bag and label it with her name. Bring only the amount she'll need for the amount of days attending ALABGS session. They are to be in the original container, the name of the medication, the dosage, the frequency of administration and the route of administration should be indicated on the label. The label should also have the name of the prescribing physician, the prescription number; date prescribed, possible adverse reaction, the specific conditions when contact should be made with the physician and other special instructions as needed. All medications brought by a citizen who is under 18 years of age shall be kept in a locked unit and shall be administered by one of our Nursing staff. A citizen may carry bee sting medications, inhalers, an insulin syringe or other medication or device used in the event of life threatening situations. Any deviation from this will be up to the Head Nurse.

You and your family are cordially invited to attend the following:

- Opening Convocation at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 17
- Inauguration of the ALABGS Constitutional Officers and Legislators at 7:00 p.m. Thursday, June 21, (due to lack of space family/guest will not be allowed at the dinner.)
- Final assembly at 10:45 a.m. Friday, June 22.

These will all be held in Kolf Center on the UW-Oshkosh campus.
